BOARD OF DIRECTORS ELECTION SCHEDULE

BTW is split into 10 Regions; 9 of these regions are in the USA and Canada and the final one covers all areas outside of the USA & Canada. Each Region has a Regional Director. The Regional Directors serve as the Board of Directors. The Board makes decisions regarding the running of BTW. Each Regional Director is elected for a three-year term by the Directors in their Regions. If your Regional Director is not participating in the Board Meetings or being in touch with the State/Chapter Directors in their region, it is up to the membership to request them to step down. The Regions are set out on the Contact page 2. For more information, contact Headquarters.

Election schedule is as follows:

2013: Regions 2 (completed), 5 (completed), 8 (pending) **2014:** Regions 3, 6, 9 **2015:** Regions 1, 4, 7, and 10

BOARD OF DIRECTORS ELECTIONS 2013

If you are a member living in Regions **2, 5 or 8** here is something to think about. **Your representative on the BOD is up for re-election during 2013.** If you want more info about being a member of the BTW Board of Directors and what it entails, contact your current BOD and ask them what they do.

It's time to vote for the person to represent them on the BTW Board of Directors for the next 3 years. If you are a member in those areas, this concerns you. At the moment your directors are;

Tom Hann has decided to retire after this term of office. (Thank you all for the time you have all spent so far helping to run this family, Shaun and Jackie). We, Shaun & Jackie, Region 10 Directors, are the people given the responsibility for finding your representative for the next 3 years.

The information is offered to help existing and those considering taking on this responsibility as a director.

CHAPTER DIRECTORS: A chapter director is required to provide the following services for his members:

- A. Coordinate the promotion of BTW to increase the membership in that chapter.
- B. Coordinate chapter activities, events and meetings
- C. Receive all requests for assistance and provide assistance with BTW issues from ALL the chapter members
- D. Provide and/or disperse all required information & materials to and from BTW and ALL the chapter members
- E. Act as a liaison and representative of BTW, making sure All members in that Chapter are properly represented and that they conduct themselves in accordance with the bi laws of BTW, Inc.
- F. Create and maintain an open communication link with their membership to ensure the flow of information and materials

STATE DIRECTORS : A State Director is required to provide the following services for his/her State:

- A. Coordinate the promotion of BTW to increase the membership in that State
- B. Receive all requests for assistance and provide assistance with BTW issues from ALL the chapter members
- C. Provide and/or disperse all required information & materials to and from BTW, Chapter Directors and ALL the members in their State
- D. Act as a liaison and representative of BTW, making sure All members in that State are properly represented and that they conduct themselves in accordance with the bi laws of BTW, Inc.
- G. Create and maintain an open communication link with their membership to ensure the flow of information and materials.

REGIONAL DIRECTORS: A Regional Director is required to provide the following services:

- A. Coordinate the promotion of BTW to increase the membership in that Region.
- B. Receive all requests for assistance and provide assistance with BTW issues from ALL director or member in that region.
- C. Provide and/or disperse all required information & materials to and from BTW, State & Chapter Directors, and ALL the members in that region.
- D. Act as a liaison and representative of BTW, making sure All members in that Region are properly represented and that they conduct themselves in accordance with the bi laws of BTW, Inc.
- E. Create and maintain an open communication link with their membership to ensure the flow of information and materials

BOARD OF DIRECTORS: A Board Member is required to provide the following services:

- A. Receive all requests for assistance and provide assistance with BTW issues from ALL directors or members of BTW.
- B. Coordinate the promotion of BTW to increase the membership.
- C. Act as a liaison and representative of BTW, making sure All members are properly represented and that they conduct themselves in accordance with the bi laws of BTW, Inc.
- D. Provide any BOD.
- E. Provide input to the board, based on the best interest of the membership, as a whole, regarding any issues pertaining to the required operations and furthering of BTW.
- F. Audit the activities of the Executive committee on a scheduled basis.
- G. Requires assistance to the Executive committee and Headquarters to improve and promote BTW as a whole.
- H. Maintain a constant communication with the entire membership of their Region through the Directors

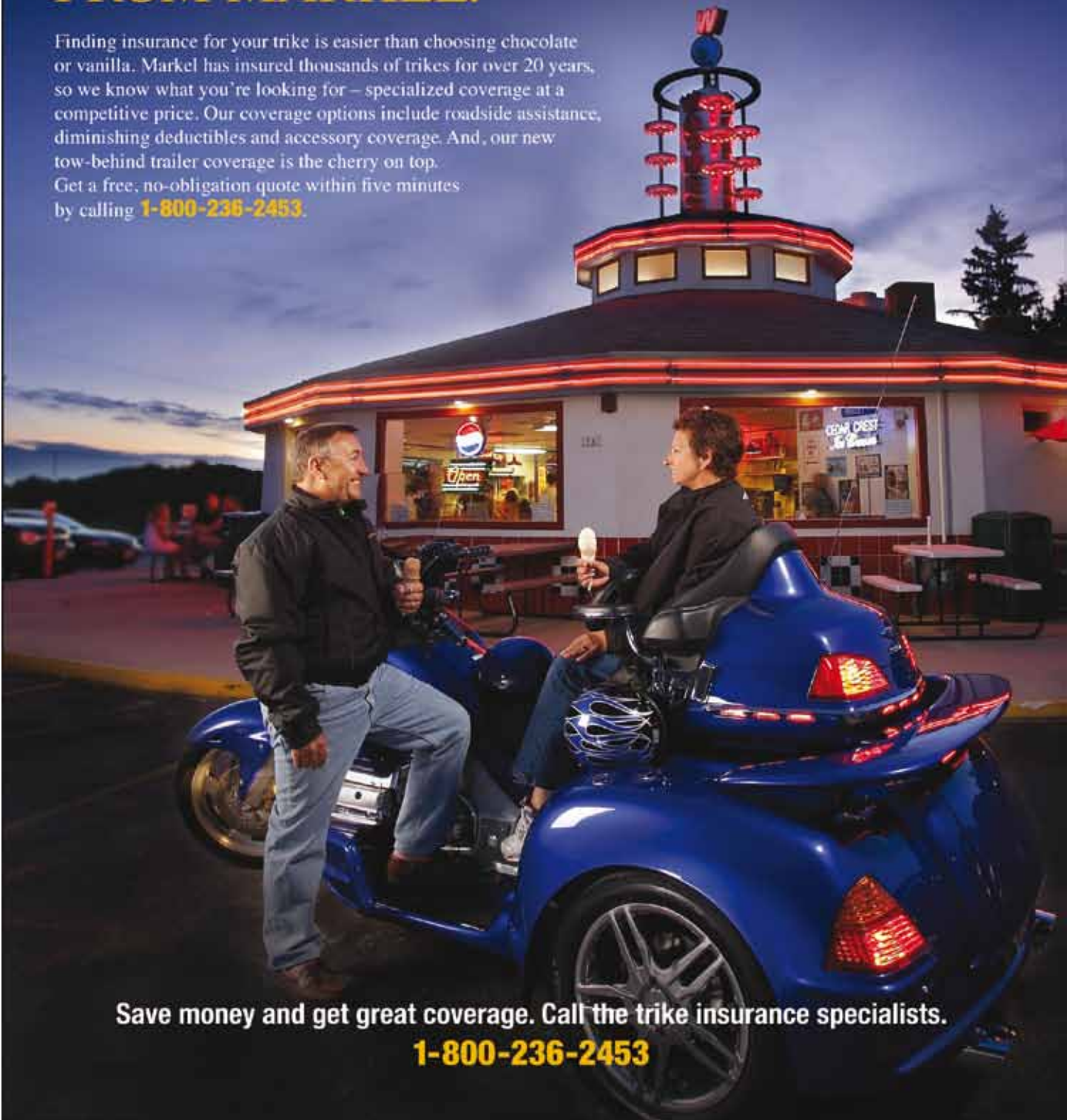

We rode the DRAGON up 129, took 72 to 411, then 306 to 165. 165 is also known as the Cherochala skyway. It goes up over 5000 ft. A bit chilly up there. The views were well worth it though. Visited Bald River Waterfall along the way. Got back to the hotel at about 7pm. Awesome day. I think it was around 100 miles or so. Not bad for the first ride of 2013. Started out Sunday full of fire, weather was great. Plotted out one of the rides suggested by a woman we met at Punkin Center at the intersection of 72 & 129. We took Rt 281 from Tuckasgee to Sapphire. Went into the store at the junction of Rt 64 & saw a t-shirt that was for "Whitewater Falls the Highest Falls East of the Mississippi" so we had to ask....
