

PHOTOS THAT WE RECEIVE AT HQ IN 72 PIXELS ARE RUN THROUGH A PROGRAM TO CLEAN THEM UP BUT NOT MUCH HAPPENS AS THE BASE IS SO LOW THAT THE PROGRAM CAN ONLY LIGHTEN OR DARKEN THEM. THIS IS JUST A TIP SO WE CAN POST BETTER PICTURES IN THE MAGAZINE TO MAKE YOUR TRIKE LOOK ITS BEST AND OF COURSE YOU AS WELL. ## NEWS FROM AROUND THE WORLD ON TRIKES

Noel Moss shares: The annual Missouri Fall Reunion Trike-In was held at Meramec Caverns on Sept 19-21, 2024. This year 23 people attended including new member Anthony Parnell from Baton Rouge, LA. Anthony took the scenic route getting here on his silver trike by way of Austin, TX and the Kansas state trike-in. Bob & Pat's BBQ in St. Clair, MO catered the event. Tom Semro brought his new white trike for its shakedown rides and Sam Lisenbee's trike sported a nifty roof that had been added just days before the trike-in. Kathy Engemann finally had enough of blown head gaskets on her V-Twin rear-engine trike so she rode her newly acquired VW powered buggy. It's a cool ride. Although some people were still arriving on day one, those of us who were already here took a ride via Hwy 47 up to Washington, MO for lunch at Marquarts Landing overlooking the Missouri River. While there, several coal trains and the Amtrak from Kansas City passed by. We took the scenic route back to the caverns via Hwy 100 and Hwy 185 over the rolling hills landscape. Day 2, we took a rather long 156-mile ride to Missouri Mines State Historic Site in Park Hills, MO, which is in the middle of the Missouri lead mining belt. The route followed Hwy 47 and Hwy 21 south, with a fuel stop in Old Mines, MO. We continued to Bonne Terre, MO and then Hwy Business 67 to Desloge where we had lunch at Ragin' Rooster Bar & Grill. After lunch we rode all of one mile to the mine facility. The entire region is honeycombed with mines, most of which are no longer in use and are flooded. The flooded Bonne Terre Mine is open to the public for walks and subterranean diving. The state historic site is a former ore processing facility that has a museum containing old mining equipment and an impressive display of crystals and ore. One of the docents gave our group a brief tour of the facility. The return ride was a scenic route via Irondale Road, Hwy M and Hwy U to a fuel stop in Potosi. Then we rode Hwy 185 to Sullvan, and the I-44 service road back to the caverns. We can't have a trike-in without at least one breakdown. Mr. Parnell's trike obliged by having a battery failure as he was pulling out onto Hwy U. Fortunately Mr. Parnell had the foresight to be carrying a set of tools and a spare battery, so we were able to do a fairly quick roadside repair and get him back on the road without any drama. Day 3- Since the previous days had been very hot and there was rain in the forecast, the 160+ mile Mark Twain State Forest ride that had originally been planned was scrapped and replaced with a shorter ride through Missouri wine country. We headed up Hwy 47 to Union, MO and then picked up Hwy V and Hwy T, a couple of very scenic and narrow twisty roads that brought us to the western suburbs of St. Louis. From there we crossed the Missouri River to Hwy 94 which follows the bluffs overlooking the river while passing many vineyards and wineries. We made a lunch stop at Wente's Roadhouse in Defiance, MO followed by an hour of riding via Hwy 94, Hwy 47 and the I-44 service road to return to the caverns. That evening we held our silent auction and had barbecued pork steaks and chicken catered by Bob & Pat's BBQ (highly recommended). Dinner and the auction were followed by a discussion regarding the 2025 Fall Reunion and Central States Trike-Ins. We have been holding the Fall Reunion Trike-In at Meramec Caverns for many years and have ridden just about all the decent ride routes in the area several times. The group's opinion was that it's time to select another venue in a different part of the state. Two possibilities are Perryville, MO, where we held the 2024 Central States Trike-In and the area near Mark Twain Lake in northern Missouri. We will be looking at other locations as well and are open to suggestions and recommendations. It was also announced that the 2025 Central States Trike-In will be held in Mountain View, AR, at Mountain View RV Park and Guest Motel. Keep an eye open for more information about both of these 2025 trike-ins.



#### **BTW BOD Elections**
