FROM THE MEMBERS

Part 3: The Natchez Trace Parkway (Our Most Excellent Adventure)

Arriving at the Meriwether Lewis National Park campground after a long, hot, ride the previous day we really appreciated the milder nighttime temperature which allowed us to get a good night's sleep. We slept later than usual so we decided to start the day with a cup o' tea and have an early lunch on the road. We reviewed our trip plan and decide to stay two nights to explore more of the surrounding area after passing a number of places of interest on the way here. With so many points of interest to stop and see along the trace and we know we will have to be selective so we can make this journey in four days. I also don't want to back-track more than we have to. Fortunately, in this area there are alternative scenic routes which allow us to make our way back to the bridge at milepost 438 and return to the campsite via the Trace.

We rolled out of the campsite and headed south to milepost 428 and headed east on Tennessee Highway 46 to Leipers' Fork. I drive through scoping out what's here and turn around and make a bee-line for Puckett's Grocery and Restaurant. I walk through the door and I can see this place has a history. A functional old-fashioned soda fountain bar, stage, grocery shelves, bare wood plank floor, a small hot food buffet in front of a grill and two cheerful women inviting us in and telling us what's on the menu. For Lunch I chose southern green bean, seasoned potato wedges, chicken sandwich, a soda, and some hard-packed ice cream. It's Monday and the entertainment doesn't start until later in the week. Yea, I could be a regular at this place even if it is the only restaurant in town.

Heading north out of town I see off in the distance a McMansion with a driveway so long I could easily hit 3rd gear long before I got near the house. As we pass the entrance gate there is a full size dead deer and five turkey vultures. What's notable about this is the deer is right up against the gate, that's not usually where road kill hits the ground. I'm thinking someone is on the opposite side of some local issue and this is a message being sent. Have I seen to many Sopranos' episodes?

Continuing north on TN 46 we exit left to TN 94 and are on our way to Birdsong Hollow. **Mile Marker (MM) 438 Double –Arch Bridge** Having rolled over this bridge the prior day we had to come back for the scenic view.

At 582 feet in height the view is country chic. I parked the trike at the end of the bridge and we walked out by the center for the view. A Ranger stopped in the southbound lane and we talked about the trike for about 10 minutes. In that time only one northbound car went by us. Did I mention there isn't much traffic on this road?


We continue south on the trace to **MM 423.9 Tennessee Valley Divide** for a quick view of lush green tree tops.

MM 375.8 Old Trace Drive Here is a 2.5 mile dirt, one lane path along the valley ridge and we decided to ride it. I was glad I didn't have the camper behind me because the farther up the road we got the more rustic the path became. The ride offered some shade and a nice valley view.

MM 350.5 Sunken Trace There are many stops where you can walk the same path that so many American Indians and early settlers had traveled. At the Sunken Trace the pathway showed three different pathways that were used when one or the other became water logged. One of the paths was worn down close to four feet from all the traffic the path bore.

Our day was coming to a close so we headed back to the Meriwether Lewis Campground for dinner. At the campsite we met another camper who was there for the week to go to the Rolling Stones

concert in Nashville the next weekend. On this night we had a surprise. About 10 p.m. fireflies began appearing. These weren't the small Northern Illinois fireflies, they were big. Really big and there were a lot of them. I tried counting them but quickly gave up as they passed in swarms. They were moving across the campground clearly with a destination in mind. I found out the next day that across from the campground is Sand Creek. This is a natural congregation point for them. They weren't synchronous fireflies like those in Kentucky, but it was still quite a site to see.

Day 2: Another decent night's sleep and with growling stomachs we decide to drive into Hohenwald for gas. Just minutes down the road we came upon a gas station that offered breakfast sandwiches. We moved on and headed downtown for a more traditional breakfast. Hohenwald looked to be an active small town. We ate at one of the local diners: county eggs, bacon, and hot coffee. Heading back to the campground I observed there were no national fast food restaurants chains in town. We bought ice and packed-up the campsite. Leaving the campground we toured the Meriwether Lewis burial monument and the cabin in which his suspicious death occurred. Not too far south of the campground the curvy road and hills began flattening out. With a few exceptions, the NTP just got flatter and straighter the farther south we went. As we depart Tennessee I feel I have seen more valleys here than anywhere I have ever traveled.

We have now crossed into the Northwest corner of Alabama where the NTP cuts through for about 25 miles.


MM 327.3 Colbert Ferry George Colbert operated a ferry across the Tennessee River from 1800-1819. Colbert once charged Andrew



Jackson \$75,000 to ferry his Tennessee Army across the river. The John Coffee Memorial Bridge now carries the NTP across the Tennessee River which is .8 mile long. **MM 317 Freedom Hills Overlook** This is the highest point on the trace. The ride up is steep and it takes you up over the valleys and treetops. Now only nine miles to the Alabama-Mississippi state line.

We make two stops in Mississippi before we arrive at the evenings' campsite. **MM 308.8 Bear Creek Mound** This flat-topped mound was built during the Mississippian period between 1100 and 1300 A.D. Archeological evidence shows this site was used by hunters as early as 8000 B.C.. **MM 308.4 Cave Spring** A long room and corridor was dissolved out of the limestone rock by the underground water.

MM 304.5 Tishomingo State Park The NTP runs directly through the Tishomingo State Park which is a nice convenience. Being a state park the nightly fee is \$6.



It is located in the foothills of the Appalachian Mountains so getting a flat campsite could be problem. The campsites encircle a large fishing pond. The first campsites we see are grass patches on the side of a hill. Farther down the road I have a sigh of relief when I see flat pull-in pads. The sites here are clean and each has a picnic table with grill and because of the terrain these sites are raised

10-15 feet above the water which provides for a nice over-water view. The shower house is brick, clean, and is air-conditioned. The A/C was really needed at this point in the trip. It was hot and the cooler ice didn't survive the day so I went out for ice and after a campsite meal we very much enjoyed some iced cocktails and watched the trees sway back and forth over the water.



.Day 3: The weather prediction is for clear skies and hot. Our next campsite is Rocky Springs Campground about 4.5 hours away. We leave mid-morning and expect a full day with the stops we make. on. **MM 287.7 Pharr Mounds** The largest and most important archaeological site in northern Mississippi was built around 100-1200 A.D.. Eight large dome shaped burial mounds are scattered over an area of 90 acres. Continued....

They were used by nomadic Indians to bury the dead with their possessions.

MM 266 Tupelo Visitor Center This is good rest stop as it is very shady with indoor plumbing. This Ranger Station is good place to pick-up maps, souvenirs, and a chance to ask rangers questions. I had a picture of a snake that I almost stepped on at a previous stop and was unfamiliar with its markings. The ranger said it is non-venomous and called it a Rat snake, a cousin to the Corn snake, who's unique characteristic, is it making itself stiff. Sometimes it can be picked-up and it will hold itself so stiff it is like holding a stick in your hand. **MM261.8 Chickasaw Village** Here are foundations of Chickasaw Indian homes and a fort. The Chickasaw used round buildings for the winter and rectangular building for summer living which were well ventilated. **232.4 Bynum Mounds** Here are six burial mounds built during the Middle Woodland period, between 100 B.C. and 100 A.D. The NTP



was a major trade route. Raw materials from as far away as Galena, Illinois; Ohio, Alabama and the Gulf Coast have been found here.

MM 204 to MM 212 Cruising along in the shade of trees I see a stretch of bright sunlight up ahead. As we come into this sunlight I am amazed at scenery like I've never seen before. On both sides of the road the tops of the evergreen trees were all missing. This lets in a whole lot of sunlight that normally isn't there and this went on for miles. This is an eight-mile section where a tornado ripped through and did a lot of damage. This occurred on April 27, 2011.



MM 180.7 French Camp It's time for a hydration and shade break so we pull into the French Camp which are log cabin buildings containing a small grill and souvenir shop along with a few antique farm implements in the yard. **MM122.6 River Bend** We've been cruising along for quite a while when I look over to the left and through the trees I see a large river. It looks like shade so I pull off the road. We engage in conversation with an local, elderly Southern Lady who is taking an out of state friend on a site seeing tour. She tells us how a past relative once owned the land where Freedom Hills Overlook (MM317) is located. According to her, the relative sold the property just before it became the National Park Service property. **MM 54. 8 Rocky Springs Campground** The sun is casting long shadows of the trees to the west and we arrive at what we are expecting to be our evening campsite. This campground must have gotten lost in the state's budget because it was so bad we decided to drive the additional hour to Natchez State Park and double back the next day to see what we passed along the way. We exit the NTP at MS 553 and in 1.6 miles we are checking in at Natchez State Park. This is a clean park with paved sites, laundry and shower facilities and all for only \$4.00 a night. After setting up the camper we drive into Natchez to find dinner. We found a restaurant with A/C in the old section of Natchez and were introduced to real southern cooking. Over dinner we worked out the plan for tomorrow and headed back to the campsite.

Day 4: **MM 15.6 Mount Locust** The farthest back we had to drive was about 7 miles to Mount Locust. There once were more than 50 road houses along the NTP and this one is the only remaining structure. Constructed about 1780 it served as a farm and Inn for the road weary. There is a small souvenir shop at the base of the hill. This is the only time I've ever see a card displaying the various types of bullets used in the civil war.



MM 10.3 Emerald Mound Heading south we stop at an Indian mound that rivals the Cahokia Mounds in western Illinois. As the second largest mound in the U.S. Emerald Mound was built during the Mississippian Period 1000 A.D. -1700 A.D. and covers eight acres. The lower mound is 35 ft. tall with another mound 25 ft. tall on top of it. Archaeologists believe the mound was used for civic and religious ceremonies. Continued....

MM 0 Southern Terminus On the fourth day of our journey we arrive at the Southern Terminus of the NTP.



We swap taking pictures with a couple bikers who are just starting their journey north and watch as they take-off on their adventure. From here you either exit left or right to Liberty Road on the edge of Natchez. We head into town for lunch and some touristy stuff. We do a self-guided walking tour, sample the local B.B.Q., and on the way out of town take the driving tour of Natchez. Now at this point we are in dire need of some strong

coffee and haven't seen any place where we can get an espresso. Just as we are nearing the end of this driving tour we spot a hand painted 8 ft. x 4 ft. sign for Steampunk Coffee Roasters. We drop-in and enjoy a well-deserved drink. We are quite entertained by the baristas who demonstrate how to make some really far- out coffee drinks. They let us take our cups outside for a toast of the finale of our trip and snap a picture for us. Though this adventure is done we still have to decide about getting home. My wife wins that conversation and we are heading to Alabama to spend Father's Day Weekend with relatives. Then, we head back to Illinois. Ride safe and ride often!
